

We Thomas J. Biggs & William Jenkins
being appointed commissioners for the Parish
of Kilbrogan at a special vestry held
in said Parish pursuant to the provisions
of 1st Geo. 4. chap 99 entitled "an act for
the establishing of composition for tithes for a
limited time" do hereby certify that at a
vestry held on the 29th day of March 1827
in said Parish it was agreed upon by
The Rev. Horatio J. Newman Rector
of said Parish and by a majority of the
vestry men then present that the sum of
six hundred and fifty pounds British
currency shall be paid as the annual
composition under the said the said
act during a period of twenty or years
for all the tithes payable out of said
Parish of Kilbrogan to the said
Rev. Horatio J. Newman Rector,

At a special Vestry legally held
in the Parish Church of Kilbrogan on
the 23rd day of April 1827 for the purpose
of taking into consideration the annexed
certificate of composition, (George Cornwall
Esq. being appointed Chairman) it was
resolved that this Vestry do agree to
accept the sum of six hundred and
fifty pounds as the composition for
the tithes of said Parish, and that
said sum shall continue to be
paid for the term of twenty or years
from the first of May next, without
variation, whatever the price of Corn
may be
