

I, *Thomas Nesbitt* (having been duly appointed and sworn a Commissioner under, and by virtue of, an Act made in the Second and Third years of the Reign of King WILLIAM IV. intituled—"An Act to amend Three Acts passed in the Fourth, Fifth, and in the Seventh and Eighth years of his late Majesty King GEO. IV., providing for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent"—to Ascertain and Fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielding or payable within the Parish of *Kilbrine* in the County of *Wexford*) do hereby Certify, that the True and Just Composition for all Tithes, whatever, within the said Parish is *Twenty Nine pounds Sterling*

by the Year, of which Sum of *Twenty Nine pounds Sterling*

One half is due and payable to *the Venible Archdeacon Oldfield* as a Composition claimable by him as *Vicar* of said Parish,

the other half is due and payable to *Lord Crofton* as *Lay Impropriator* of said Parish,

And I do further Certify, that the average price of Oats—being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of Seven Years, ending the First Day of November, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty—is

Twelve shillings and 7½ pence per Barrel.
