duly appointed under and by virtue of an Act made  
in the 4<sup>th</sup> of George 4<sup>th</sup> <sup>1804</sup> intituled an Act to provide for  
the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland  
for a limited time, to ascertain and fix a true and  
just Composition for all Tithes, arising, growing,  
yielded, or payable within the Parish of Killea-  
van in the County of Wexford, do hereby certify that  
the true and just amount of Composition for all  
Tithes whatever within the said Parish, as agreed  
upon by the incumbent, and the Parishioners  
duly assembled in vestry, and certified by the Church-  
warden and others, and approved of by the Lord Bishop  
of Ferns, is four hundred Pounds Sterling  
by the year, and that the same is to continue  
without variation or alteration for one & twenty  
years the whole of which sum is due & payable  
to Rev. Dean Browne, a Rector of said Parish
