We the Rev^d John Delinney of Gort and Henry Cannon of Millmount County of Galway Esq^s Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and Virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the Fourth entitled "an act to provide for the establishment of compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time" and by the amended act 5th Geo. 4th Chap 63 to ascertain and fix a true and Just composition for all tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Kilchrist in the County of Galway, do hereby certify that the true and Just amount of Composition for all tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the parish of Kilchrist is eighty eight pounds sterl^s (British Currency) by the year, of which sum of eighty eight pounds sterl^s, Sixty six pounds sterl^s are due and payable to the Rev^d Edward Hartigan and his successors as a composition for all tithes claimable by him &c as Rector of said parish Three pounds sterl^s are due and payable to the Lessees of the Vicars Choral of Christ Church Dublin as composition for a portion of the tithes of the townland of Goitnamonagh in said parish, and nineteen pounds sterl^s are due and payable to the Bishop of the Diocese of Kilmacduagh. And we further certify that the Composition is to continue in force for twenty one years from the 1st of Nov. 1826. sic without alteration according to the provisions of the said acts of Parliament.

And we certify its amount to be eighty eight pounds of which the following sums are payable to the following persons viz. To the Rev^d Edward Hartigan as rector of said parish the sum of sixty six pounds per annum, to the lessees of the Vicars Choral of Christ Church Dublin for a portion of the tithes of the townland of Goitnamonagh the sum of three pounds per annum; To the Lord Bishop of the Diocese of Kilmacduagh the sum of nineteen pounds per annum.
