

A copy of the Certificate of the Commissioners
for the Parish of Kilsheaph, near Morte, in
the Diocese of Meath, Co. of Westmeath, respecting
the Composition entered into on the 17th of December
1823 for the tythes of said Parish -

We Joseph M. Daly, & Edwin T. Matthews
Commissioners appointed & sworn under & by
virtue of an act made in the fourth year
of the reign of King George the Fourth, intituled
"An act to provide for the establishing of
compositions for tythes in Ireland for a
limited time. Do hereby certify that a
composition was agreed to in a special
Meeting held in the Parish Church of Morte
Parish of Kilsheaph, Diocese of Meath, Co. of
Westmeath, by which the Parish have
agreed to give the Rev. Arthur Colleton
Incumbent of said Parish, Three hundred
Pounds that per year for the tythes of said
Parish, which sum the said Arthur Colleton
consented & agreed to receive & which composi-
tion was entered into & agreed upon, on
the seventeenth day of December 1823
And we do further certify that the true &
just amount of composition for all tythes
whatsoever within said Parish is Three
hundred Pounds per year - Joseph M. Daly
