

An Amended Certificate of Tithes Composition
for the parish of Kileock Diocese and County Kildare
By order of His Excellency the Lord Lieutenant
and Council bearing date the 28th day October 1833

I Joseph Henry Wybrants having been duly
appointed and sworn Commissioner under and by
Virtue of a act made in the fourth year of the reign
of King George the fourth entitled an act to provide
for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland
for a limited time and by Virtue of an act passed in
the second and third years of the reign of His Majesty
King William the fifth entitled an act to amend three
acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth and in
the seventh and eighth years of the reign of His late
Majesty King George the fourth providing for the estab-
-lishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make
such compositions permanent and to ascertain and fix
a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing
yielded or payable within the Parish of Kileock in the
County of Kildare do hereby certify that the true and
just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever
within the said parish is One Hundred and Sixty-
-eight pounds by the year of which sum of £168
one shilling and payable as follows To the Rev Charles
Caulfield the Vicar of said parish the Great and one
third of the small Tithes arising out of the Townlands
of Boycetown and Kileock producing the sum of Twenty-
-eight pounds by the year, and a further sum of
