Great or Corn Tithes of those Six Townlands and paya-
ble to Him as Lay Impropriator, To Joseph Thomas
Walker Esquire the sum of Fourteen pounds being
the two-thirds of the small Tithes arising out of the
Townlands of Boycetown and Kilececk, And a further
sum of Twentyeight pounds by the year is due and pay-
able to the said Joseph Thomas Walker Esq for His
proportionate part of the small Tithes arising out the

£14 and £28 making £42 being the Amount
