

1) I, John Hooppy and Mr. Geoffrey Lynch commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth intituled "An act to provide for the establishment of compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all tithes whatsoever arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Kildeman in the County of Kerry do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is Three hundred and Eighty Pounds by the year of which sum of Three hundred and Eighty Pounds Three hundred and fifty Pounds is due and payable to John Leary Genl. and Thirty Pounds is due and payable to John Shea Lawlor Esq. as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by them as the Lessees of the lay Impropriator of the said Parish and we do further Certify that the average price of oats being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November 1821 ^{to wit} was as fifteen Shillings and two pence ^{per bush} Baril Date Nov 20th 1823.
