The Alderman of Millpark in the County of Wick
Egmond and the Reverend William Baker-Joy of Leekie
in the Kings County, Clerk, Commissions duly ap-
pointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act
made in the fourth year of the Reign of King
George the Fourth entitled an Act to provide for the
Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland
for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and
just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing,
gilded or payable within the Parish of Killedeeman
situate in the Kings County of Ireland do hereby Certify
that the Parishioners of said Parish of Killedeeman
have agreed to and with the Reverend Thomas S'Strange
Clerk Vicar of said Parish and the Reverend Abraham
Downes Clerk Extra of Union of Birr and owners of
the Rectorial Tithes of said Parish of Killedeeman to
pay unto them the said Reverend Thomas S'Strange
and Reverend Abraham Downes the sum of Seven
Hundred and fifteen Pounds Sterling, and that the
said Reverend Thomas S'Strange and Reverend
Abraham Downes having agreed to accept the
same as the annual amount of the Composition,
that the same is the true and just amount of
Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said
Parish of Killedeeman of which sum of Seven
Hundred and fifteen Pounds the sum of Seventy
five Pounds is due and payable to the said Rev
Thomas S'Strange as a Composition for all Tithes
