

Kilcolman
 Infirmity. -
 Proceedings at Special
 Vestry under the 5th
 Census Act. -
 5th July 1830

A meeting of the Parish of Kilcolman
 was held at the Church of the said Parish
 at 8 o'clock for a Special Vestry issued
 by his Excellency the Lord Bishop of Limerick
 to certain Acts of Parliament for the purpose
 of settling the Parishes for the purpose
 and William Richards
 presented to the Vestry and read the same
 which were legally entitled to vote and
 having been duly announced & appearing
 at the Vestry.

Richards that in case of agreement that a sum
 of twenty pounds the year is a fair composition
 for all tithes owing to the Vicar of the
 Parish of Kilcolman and the same called Kilcolman
 in tithes, and that he hereby agree to pay to the
 Rev. Henry Gibbin incumbent of said Parish
 and to his successors Incumbents in said
 Parish the sum of twenty pounds Sterling
 in tithes and satisfaction of all tithes payable
 in said Parish for and during the Term
 of Twenty one years and that this our agree-
 ment be submitted to The Lord Bishop of
 Limerick for his Lordships approval. -
 Dated this 5th July 1830.
