a True and Just Composition for all Tithes growing
yielding or payable within the parish of Killeen
in the County of Mayo. Do hereby Certify that the
true and Just amount of Composition for all Tithes
whatsoever within the said parish is Three
Hundred and Thirty pounds $\text{£}330$ by the
Year of which Sum of Three Hundred and
Thirty pounds the entire is due and payable
to the Rev^d Joseph D. Grey D.D. as a composition
for the Tithe Claimable by him as Rector of
said parish

And we do further Certify that
the average price of Oats being the Corn principally
grown in said County for the period of Seven
Years ending on the first day of November
one Thousand eight Hundred and Twenty one
is thirteen Shillings per Barrel. Given under
Our hands this 26th day of February 1824
