I John W. Andrews - Commissioner duly appointed
and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the
2^d & 3^d years of the Reign of King William the fourth prom-
ising for the Establishing of a Composition for tithes in
Ireland and to make such Composition permanent to as-
ertain and fix a true and just Composition for all tithes
arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of
Killeen in Co. Mayo and Diocese of Killaloe
do hereby Certify that the true and just Amount of
Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said
Parish, is Three Hundred and Forty Pounds Sterling
per year of which sum of Three Hundred and Forty
Pounds Sterling One Half part is due and payable to
the Reverend Thomas Sutton for the Tithes claimed
by him as Rector of the said Parish and the other
One Half part is due and payable to the Reverend Samuel
Stock as owner of the Vicarial tithes of the said Parish

And - I do further Certify that the average
price of oats being the Corn, principally grown in the
said County of Mayo for the Period of Seven years ending
on the first day of November One Thousand Eight Hundred
and Thirty is Twelve Shillings and Eleven Pence Sterling
per Barrel of Fourteen Stone
