Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain and find  
a true & just composition for all Tithes arising  
growing yielded and payable within the parish of  
Kilcommur in the County of Wicklow do hereby  
certify that the true and just amount of Compo-  
sition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish  
is Four hundred and ninety five pounds by the  
year. Of which sum the whole amount is due  
and payable to the Rector of said Parish as a  
composition for all Tithes claimable by him -

And We do further certify that the average  
Price of Oats being the corn principally grown in  
such county for the period of seven years ending  
on the first day of November 1821 was in Fifteen  
Shillings and two pence farthing by the barrel
