year of the reign of King George the Fourth, entitled an Act to provide  
for the Establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a  
limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for  
all Tithes, arising, growing, yielding, or payable within the  
Parish of Millwidmore, in the Ancient Diocese of Cloyne and  
Aghadae and County of Kerry, do hereby Certify that the true and  
just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the  
said Parish is Eighty Pounds by the year, of which sum of Eighty  
Pounds one half thereof is due and payable to the Rev. Richard  
Herbert as a Composition for the Tithe claimable by him  
as Vicar of the said Parish and the other one half thereof is  
due and payable to John Shea Lavelle, Inquire as owner or occupier  
of the Improper Tithes of the said Parish

And we do further Certify that the average price  
of Oats (being the Corn principally grown in said County) for the  
period of seven years ending on the first day of November 1825  
is Fifteen Shillings and Two pence farthing per Barrel
