within the Parish of Kilcroan and County of Galway
I do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of compo-
sitions for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is One
hundred and ^{£106-15-0} Six pounds fifteen Shillings by the year
of which sum of One hundred and Six pounds Fifty-
three pounds Seven Shillings and six pence Sterling
are due and payable to the ^{now} Vicar as a composition for
the Tithe Claimable by him as Vicar of the said Parish
and Fifty three pounds Seven Shillings and six pence Sterling
are due and payable to the Lessee of the Improvements
as Owner of the Rectorial Tithes of the said Parish

And I do further Certify that the average price of Corn
being the Corn principally grown in such County
for the period of seven years ending the first of
November 1830 (thirty) is fifteen Shillings and three
pence per Barrel
