under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the Fourth entitled an Act to provide for the establishing of a Commission for tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Purris Kilcrohane in the County of Cork and claimable by the Rev<sup>d</sup> Edward Jones Alcock as Vicar of said Parish by Alexander O'Briscoll Esq<sup>r</sup> Lessee of Improprate tithes of part of said Parish and by Nathaniel Evanson of Freshy Lane Esq<sup>r</sup> as Lessee of the Improprate tithes of another part of said Parish. do hereby certify that the true and just amount of composition for all tithes claimable within the said Parish by the Reverend Edward Jones Alcock as Vicar of the said Parish and by Alexander O'Briscoll Esq<sup>r</sup> as Lessee of the Improprate Tithes of part of said Parish and by Nathaniel Evanson as Lessee of the Improprate Tithes of another part of said parish is Seven hundred and twenty pounds Stg by the year being the sum agreed upon between the Parishioners and the said Rev. Edward Jones Alcock, Alexander O'Briscoll Esq<sup>r</sup> and Nathaniel Evanson Esq<sup>r</sup> at a Vestry<sup>W. M.</sup> solemnly summoned and held in pursuance of the act of Parliament in such case made and provided of which the sum of Three hundred and twenty pounds Stg is due and payable
