 Skilleshane, in the County of Kerry. Do hereby
 Certify that the true and just amount of Composition
 for all tithes, whatever within the said Parish is
 Two hundred and eighty Pounds sd by the year
 as agreed upon this day, at a Vestry legally held in
 the Parish Church, between the Parsonages at said
 Vestry assembled, and the Rev^d Mountford Longfield
 Rector of said Parish, the whole of the said sum
 of two hundred and eighty pounds, being payable
 to the said Rector, Dated this 17th Day of August
 1825 in give
