We the Commissioners duly appointed and sworn pursuant to the Act 1st Geo. 4th for Establishing a Composition for all Tithes in Ireland do certify that this is a fair and just apportionment of all the Lands in the said Parish of Kilcullen aforesaid County of Kildare -

We hereby Certify that the true and just amount of composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is Three Hundred and Sixty Pounds and Eight pence sterling. The sum of Two hundred and thirteen Pounds fifteen Shillings and three pence Sterling are due and payable by the year to the Rev^d Mr. Trench Chancellor of Christ Church as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of said Parish. - The sum of Forty Pounds eight Shillings and Eight pence Sterling is due and payable by the year to the Rev^d John Robinson Vicar of Christ Church as a Composition for two fifths of the Townlands of Kilcullen, Halverstown, Kilgowan - and Nicholasstown. - and the sum of one Hundred and five Pounds sixteen Shillings and nine pence sterling is due and payable by the year to the Rev^d John Hardy as a Composition for the whole of the Tithes arising growing and payable in the Townlands of Gormanstown, Killineen, and Gilbinstown in said Parish claimable by him as a perpetual Curate of said Parish. -

We further Certify that this statement is correct according to the best of our Skill and judgement.
