We, Alexander Glendinning and Frederick Stock Commissioners duly  
Appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the Fourth year of  
the Reign of King George the Fourth, intituled "An Act to provide for the establish-  
ing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain and  
fix a true and just Composition for all tithes arising growing or yielded or  
payable within the Parish of Kilmummin in the County of Mayo, do hereby  
Certify that the true and just Composition for all tithes whatever within  
the said Parish of Kilmummin is one hundred and sixty pounds Sterling by  
the year of which sum of one hundred and sixty pounds, Sixty seven pounds  
thereof be paid to the Vicar of said Parish in full for the vicarial tithe and  
claimable off all lands in the said parish save the Town lands of Kilmummin  
and Ballygarry, the whole tithes whereof are payable to the Rector, that  
Ninety three pounds be paid to the Rector in full for the Rectorial tithes  
and claimable off all lands in the said parish. And we do further  
Certify that the average price of oats being the Corn principally grown in  
such County for the period of Seven years ending on the first day of November  
1821 is fifteen shillings & two pence farthing per barrel
