tythes in Ireland for a limited time and ascertain and fix a true  
and ~~limited~~ just Composition for all tythes growing yielded or payable  
within the parish of ~~Kilcannon~~ in the County of Mayo do hereby  
certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all  
tythes whatever within the said parish is four Hundred &  
Thirty three pounds

by the year the whole is due and payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> John  
Gerge as a Composition for the tythe claimable by him as Rector  
and Vicar of the said parish and we do further certify that the  
average price of Oats being the corn principally grown in such  
County for the period of seven years ending on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of  
Nov<sup>r</sup> 1824 is fifteen shillings & 6 pence according to the  
Price extracted from the Dublin Gazette
