growing yielded or payable within the Parish of
Kilcumney alias Drummerie in the County of Westmeath
do hereby certify that the true and just amount of
Compositions for all tithes whatever within the said Parish
is one hundred and thirty pounds by the year, of which
sum of one hundred and thirty pounds the whole is due
and payable to the Reverend Michael De Courcy D. D. as
a composition for the tithes claimable by him as
Rector of the said Parish -

And we do farther certify that the aver-
-age price of oats being the Corn principally grown
in ~~the~~ ^{such} County for the period of seven years ending
on the first day of November 182 one is fifteen
shillings and two pence farthing.
