 of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a
 limited time to ascertain & fix a true &
 just composition for all tithes arising, grow-
 -ing, yielded or payable within the Parish
 of Kilmumney, alias, Dumenec in the
 County of Westmeath, do hereby Certify,
 that the true & just amount of Compo-
 -sition for all Tithes whatever, within
 the said Parish, is One hundred and
 Thirty pounds by the year. Of which sum
 of One hundred & thirty pounds, the whole
 is due and payable to the Reverend
 Michael De Lancy, D. D. as a composition
 for the tithes claimable by him as Rector
 of the said Parish. —

And we do further certify, that the
 average price of oats, being ~~the~~ corn prin-
 -cipally grown in such County, for the period
 of seven years, ending on the first day of No-
 -vember, 1821 is fifteen shillings & two
 pence farthing. —
