We The Commissioners appointed under the Tithe Composition Act, to assess, and apportion  
in the Corporation of Kildare the sum of three Hundred and twenty three pounds one shilling  
and six pence half penny British, (being the Amount of Composition agreed upon by  
the Parishioners assembled in Vestry with Henry Cooper Esq<sup>r</sup> - on behalf of the Tithe Owners of said  
Corporation) equally on all the Lands in the said Corporation. Thus according to the best  
of our Judgment and abilities viewed every farm and plot of ground, and  
have set forth the quality of Land contained in each as compared with the  
remainder of the Parish, and the gross amount of Acres, Rods, and Perches, taken in most  
cases from actual survey. And We do hereby further certify that the above sum of  
Three hundred and twenty three pounds one shilling and six pence British is a  
true and just Amount of Composition for all tithes due and payable to him the said  
Henry Cooper (on behalf of the Tithe Owners of said Corporation) by the Year. We have divided  
the arable and Pasture Land into four Qualities, charging the first quality a 3.7<sup>6</sup> -  
the 2<sup>d</sup> do a 2-6 - the 3<sup>d</sup> do a 1-5, and the 4<sup>th</sup> do a 10 pence - The Average Price  
of Wheat for seven years next preceding 1821 one <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> 18-8 <sup>6</sup>/<sub>10</sub> into Irish Currency being the principal  
Corn grown in such County - Dated this 26 day of March 1827 Wm. M. M. M.
