Tithes in Ireland for a limited Time", to ascertain and fix
a true and just Composition for all tithes arising, growing,
yielded or payable within the Corporation or Parish of
Kildare in the County of Kildare, do hereby certify that
the true and just amount of Composition for all tithes
whateven within the said Corporation or Parish, is Three
Hundred and twenty three pounds one Shilling and
six pence British by the Year - Which Sum is due and
payable to The Very Rev^d The Dean & Chapter of Kildare
as Owners of said Tithes, or to their Lessees -

And We do further certify that the Average Price of
Wheat, being the Corn principally grown in such
County, for the Period of seven years, ending on the 31 day
of December 1820 is £ 1 - 18 - 8 (late Irish Currency)
per Barrel.
