

I *Edward Plunkett* a Commissioner, duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of an Act made in the Second and Third Year of the Reign of King William the Fourth, intituled "An Act to amend Three Acts passed respectively in the Fourth, Fifth, and in the Seventh and Eighth Years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent," to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielding, or payable within the Parish of *Stildavin* in the County of *Wexford*. *Dioec. of Ferns*
Do hereby Certify that the true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever, within the said Parish, is *one hundred and twenty five pounds* by the Year,

of which Sum of *one hundred and twenty five pounds* is due and payable to *The Rev. William Hickey* as a Composition for the Tithe claimable by *Him as Rector of said Parish*

And I do hereby Certify that the average price of *Oats* being the Corn principally grown in such *Parish* for the period of Seven Years, ending on the 1st day of November, 1830, is *twelve shillings and eleven pence half-penny* per Barrel.
