notice in writing in the words and figures following
"Sir you are hereby required to take notice that in
pursuance of an Act passed in the second and third
years of his present Majesty entitled an Act to amend
three Acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth and
in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of his
late Majesty King George the fourth providing for the
re-establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and
to make such Compositions permanent the Lord of
Courtown and Jerome W. Knapp Esq on behalf of Stephen
Rams a minor

of Ramsfortpark in the County of Wexford being all that and
those the Townland of Staplestown containing Forty
one Acres three Roods and thirty perches late Irish
Measurement or thereabouts and set down in the
Composition Book for said Parish as containing Forty Eight
Acres late Irish Measure

situate in the parish of Mildmay Barony of Forth
and County of Wexford or otherwise entitled according
to the provisions of said Act to agree for and under
take the payment of the Compositions for Tithes
lawfully payable for and in respect of such lands
do hereby signify to you our desire to agree for and
undertake the future payment of such Compositions
as aforesaid for and in respect of said lands and
we hereby require you to grant us a Certificate
in writing conformable to the provisions of said
Act declaring us entitled to the benefit of this notice
and to perform the other matters on your part
required by the said Act to be done Dated this
10th day of October 1834
