limited time": To ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all
Tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable within the Parish of Kildelley in
the Queens County—

We hereby certify that the true and just
amount of Compositions for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish
is Fifty seven pounds ten Shillings Sterling by the Year, being the Sum
agreed to at and by a Special Vestry held on the fourteenth day of
June last in said Parish under the provisions of said Act with the Rev.
Marcus Monck Incumbent of said Parish, and said
Composition to continue invariable for a term of Twenty one Years.

And

We do further certify that the average price of Wheat being the Corn
principally grown in said County for the period of Seven Years
ending the first day of November one thousand eight hundred and
twenty one is twenty Shillings per Barrel.
