do hereby certify that the true and just amount
of composition for all tithes whatsoever within the said
parish is two hundred British currency by the
year, which sum is due and payable to the
Reverend Arthur Ellis as a composition for the
tithes claimable by him as Rector of the said
parish. And we do further certify that the
average price of oats being the corn principally
grown in such county for the period of seven
years ending on the first day of November one
thousand eight hundred & twenty one is
fifteen shillings and two pence farthing take
currency dated this 23 day of October 1829
