in the County of Kilkenny Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under
and by Virtue of an Act made in the 11th Year of the Reign of George the 4th
entitled an Act to provide for the establishment of Composition for Tithes in Ireland
for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all
Tithes, arising growing Yields, or payable, within the Parish of Kilderry in
the Diocese of Ossory and County of Kilkenny, do hereby Certify that the true and
just amount of Composition for the Rectorial Tithe of S. Parish is one Hundred
and Sixty Pounds ⁵/₁₀ of British Currency by the Year, and is due and pay-
able to the Reverend Samuel F Roberts as a Composition for the Tithes
claimable by him as Rector of said Parish and that the agreement shall be
in force for the Term of Twenty one Years from the first Day of Novem-
ber 1828 and the first half Years Tithe to be payable on the first Day
of May following
