Wray Maunsell, Archdeacon of Limerick, do ~~solely~~ certify, that the true & just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Part of said Parish is — Three hundred Pounds by the Year; due & payable to him, as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him, as Rector ~~of~~ ~~the~~ of said Parish —

And We do further certify, that the Average Price of Wheat, being the Corn principally grown in such County, for the Period of seven Years ending on the 31st Day of December — is 11. 10. $\frac{7}{8}$ Shillings for Bannell of twenty Stones —
