Virtue of an Act made in the 4<sup>th</sup> Year of the Reign  
of King George the Fourth, Intituled an Act for  
providing for the establishing of composition of  
Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, to ascertain  
and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes  
arising, growing, yielded or payable within the  
following five Townlands of the Parish of Kildimo  
viz Ballycasey, Ballyvarren, Coolby, Craganuen, and  
Knockree in the County of Limerick; Do hereby  
certify that the true and just amount of Compo:  
sition for all Tithes whatever within the said  
five Townlands is One Hundred and Twenty  
nine pounds Six Shillings and two pence  
Imperial currency by the Year, of which the  
whole is due and payable to the said Justice Franklin  
Curate of said Parish.
