Perpetual Curacy of said Parish, by Virtue of an Act pass-
ed in the fourth Year of the Reign of King George the
Fourth, intituled "an Act to provide for the establish-
ment of Compositions of Tithes in Ireland for a limited
Time," according to the Directions of the said Act, &
according to Equity & good Conscience, & without Fa-
vor or Affection, Prejudice or Partiality to any Person,
or Persons whomsoever — To help me, God.
