Tithe Rentcharge Order

By the Justices assigned to keep the Peace in and for the  
County of Cork assembled at a General Quarter Sessions of the Peace  
helden at Fermoy in and for the division of Midleton in Cork County  
East Riding on Monday the 28<sup>th</sup> day of June 1875

Whereas due Notice having been first affixed at the times and  
in the manner directed by the Statutes in such case made and provided  
by the said Revd William Henry Nason the Lay Impropriator of said Parish  
the person receiving and entitled to receive the rentcharge payable in lieu of  
the Composition for all the Improper Tithes within such Parish made  
by the Certificate of John Ross a Commissioner bearing date the  
Nineteenth day of November One thousand Eight hundred and  
thirty three and in pursuance of the statutes in such case made and  
provided And by which Certificate the Gross amount of composition  
for all Tithes whatever in said Parish was certified to the annual  
sum of Three hundred and nineteen pounds two shillings  
whereas one half to wit the sum of One hundred and fifty nine  
pounds Eleven shillings was certified to be due and payable to the  
Honorable and Reverend Ludlow Jonson the then Vicar of said Parish  
each and every year and the other half thereof was certified to  
be payable to John Nason Esq<sup>r</sup> the then lay Impropriator  
of said Parish each and every year which said other half amounts  
to the sum of One hundred and fifty nine pounds Eleven shillings  
And whereas the said Reverend William Henry Nason the  
present Impropriator of said Parish made application in

writing to the Justices of the Peace at the Quarter Session  
above mentioned to have the average price of oats being  
the grain in said Certificate mentioned for the preceding  
seven years in pursuance of the Statutes in that behalf  
enquired of and ascertained in order that the said  
Composition for tithes and the tithe rent charge in  
lieu thereof might be increased according to such average  
price as compared with the average price of Twelve shillings  
and Eleven pence half penny set forth in said Certificate  
And whereas the said Applicant having appeared in  
person and by his Agent before the said Justices at  
such Quarter Sessions And the said Notices of Application  
of application and said Certificate and the title of the  
applicant having been proved Now the said Justices  
do ascertain from the said Gazette that the average price  
of oats for the said period of seven years immediately pre-  
ceding the date hereof is fifteen shillings and one penny  
half penny sterling for each barrel of fourteen stone And  
the said Justices do accordingly Order and adjust that  
the amount of said Composition in said Parish for the said  
Improper tithes and the rentcharge payable in lieu thereof shall  
be increased in proportion to the difference between the said average price  
of fifteen shillings and one penny half penny sterling for the period of seven years  
and the average price twelve shillings and Eleven pence half penny stated in  
in the Certificate of the Composition And the said Justices do further Order  
that the apportionment of such composition shall be amended and increased  
accordingly and that the said increase shall take effect from the first day of  
November one thousand eight hundred and seventy five
