

J. New Pop. Commissioner, duly appointed and sworn
under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and
third years of the reign of King William the fourth,
entituled, an Act to amend three Acts, passed respectively
in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh, and eighth years
of the reign of his late Majesty, King George the fourth
providing for the establishing of Composition for tithes in
Ireland, and to make such Composition permanent -
to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for
all tithes, arising, growing, yielded, or payable, within
the Parish of Kildorrery in the County of Cork, do hereby
certify, that the true and just amount of Composition
for all tithes whatever, within the said Parish is, three
Hundred and Nineteen pounds two shillings, ~~sterling of~~
the year, of which sum of Three Hundred and Nineteen
pounds, two shillings, ~~sterling~~, one half, that is to say,
One Hundred and Fifty nine pounds, Eleven shillings,
is due and payable, to the Honourable and Rev^d
Ludlow Tinson, as a Composition, for the tithes
claimable by him, as Vicar of the said, Parish, and
the other half, that is to say One Hundred and Fifty
nine pounds, Eleven shillings, is due and payable
to John Mason Esquire, as a Composition for the tithes
claimable by him, as Lay Impropriator of the said Parish
And I do further certify, that the average price
of Oats, being the corn principally grown in such
