

and adjusted that the amount of said Composition in said Parish for the said Improprate Tithes and the Rent Charge payable in lieu thereof should be increased in proportion to the difference between the said average price of 15/11<sup>2</sup> for the period of seven years and the average sum of 12/11<sup>2</sup> stated in the Certificate of Composition. And it was further Ordered that the apportionment of such Composition should be amended and increased accordingly, and that the increase should take effect from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1875.

And whereas the average price of oats for the past seven years as appears from the Dublin Gazette is less by one tenth at least than the average price as set forth in said Order of the 28<sup>th</sup> June 1875.

Now take notice that we being three persons in said Parish each charged with the annual payment of £3 and upwards in respect of the rent Charge in said Parish in lieu of such Composition will apply to the Justices assigned to keep the Peace in and for the County of Cork who shall be assembled at the General Quarter Sessions of the Peace to be holden at Middleton in and for the Division of Middleton, Cork County, East Riding, on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of October 1889 that the Composition for tithes in the said Parish in lieu whereof the tithes rent Charge may be diminished in proportion to the difference between the average price of said grain for the past seven years to be ascertained from the Dublin Gazette, and the average

price of 15/11<sup>2</sup> stated in said Order of the 28<sup>th</sup> June 1875 and that apportionment of said Composition may be amended accordingly, and that if it should be deemed necessary that an Arbitrator be appointed pursuant to the power given by the Fourth George the Fourth, Chapter 99, Section 43, to ascertain the average price of such grain as aforesaid from the Dublin Gazette for the last seven years, and to report the same, and to make the necessary adjournment for the report, and upon such report such diminution shall be made in such tithes rent Charge as shall be fit.
