My Lord

It is hereby certified for the Information of  
your Grace that at a special Vestry held this day pursuant  
to his Excellency the Lord Lieutenant's Directions, under the  
provisions of the 14<sup>th</sup> of Reg. the 4<sup>th</sup> Chap. 99 in the Parish  
of Wicklow in the Diocese of Dublin and County  
of Wicklow, it was unanimously agreed to, by the Vestry,  
and the Ecclesiastical Incumbent, the Rev Robert  
Cottonham that the sum of One Hundred and  
Forty five pounds Sterling should be paid as the  
annual Compensation under the said Act, for all  
the tithes payable out of said Parish, and it was  
also unanimously agreed to by the said Parishioners  
and Incumbent, that Mr Henry Barker of Droghda  
Co. Wicklow, and Mr James Broc of Colbride Co. Wicklow  
do act as Commissioners to carry the said Compensation  
into Effect subject to your Grace's Approbation—
