June 14th 1850

My Lord

At a special Vestry held this day under the
Provisions of the Tithe Composition Act for the Parish of
Kildrought in the County of Wicklow in your Grace's
Diocese, I have made an agreement with the
Parishioners of said Parish, to receive the Annual Sum
of One Hundred and forty five pounds Sterling
for all the Tithes in said Parish of Kildrought, the same
to continue for the term of twenty one years from the first day
of November next. And I have also agreed to the nomination
of Mr Henry Barker of Ardara C. Wicklow, and Mr James
Brook of Celbridge C. Wicklow to act as Commissioners to
carry the said Composition into effect, in the manner
prescribed by said Act, subject to your Grace's Assent
and Approbation. Said Barker having been nominated
by me as my confidential agent. I have the honor to be your Grace's
His Grace the
Archbishop of Dublin &c.
