and fix a true and just Compothion for all Vicarial Tithe now
growing, yielded, or payable within the Parish of Kiltarney in the
County of Clare, Do hereby certify that the true and just
Amount of Compothion for all Vicarial Tithe whelsum within
the said Parish is two Hundred and fifty Eight pounds fifteen
Shillings 11^s. which sum of two Hundred and fifty Eight pounds
fifteen Shillings 11^s. are due and payable to the Reverend
Andrew Davoren as a Compothion for the Tithe claimable by
him, as Vicar of the said Parish.

And We do further certify that the average price of
Wheat, being the main principally grown in such County, for
the period of seven years ending on the first day of November
one thousand eight Hundred and twenty one is fifteen
Shillings & two pence per barrel.
