do hereby certify that the true & just amount of Compositions for all
Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Two hundred & forty
Pounds seventeen shillings & six pence halfpenny by the year
of which sum of Two hundred & forty pounds seventeen shillings and
six pence $\frac{1}{2}$ and half is due and payable to the Earl of Cork as
a composition for the Tithes claimable by him as owner of the Rectorial
Tithes and the other half is due & payable to the Rev. Michael
Dejoury as owner of the Vicaral Tithes of said Parish

And we do further certify that the
average price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in such County
for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November 1823
is fifteen shillings per Barrel.
