under and by Virtue of an Act made in the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> years of the  
Reign of King William the 1<sup>st</sup>. Intituled an Act, to amend  
three Acts pass<sup>d</sup> respectively in the 11<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> and in the 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup>  
years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the 1<sup>st</sup>.  
to provide for the Establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland  
for a limited time. to Ascertain and fix a true and just  
Composition, for all Tithes arising, growing, yielding or payable  
within the Parish of Wilfere in the County of Wiltshire.  
do Certify that the true and just Amount of Composition  
for all Tithes whatever within the Said Parish is

Thirty two pounds six shillings & one penny  
which Sum is due, and payable to Lady Sybil  
Caldwell as Lay Impropriator

And, I, do further Certify that the Average price of  
Wheat being the Corn principally grown in Said County for the  
Period of Seven years Ending the 1<sup>st</sup> Day of November 1830,  
is One pound Twelve Shillings & one halfpenny per Barrel
