to ascertain and fix a true and just amount of Composi-
-tion for all tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable
within the parish of Killeenagh in the County of Limerick,
do certify that the true and just amount of Composition
for all tithes whatever within the said parish is three
hundred and thirty seven pounds ten shillings, Sixpence
per Annum, of which sum of three hundred and
thirty seven pounds ten shillings, two thirds, viz. two
hundred and twenty five pounds, are due and pay-
-able to Roger Keating Sheehy and Bryan Keating Sheehy
Esqrs as a Composition for the tithes claimable by them
as joint Lay Impropriators, and one third part, viz. one
hundred and twelve pounds ten shillings is due
and payable to the Rev. Edward Ashe the Vicar of
Said parish, and that the aforesaid Roger Keating
