TAKE NOTICE, that it is the intention of us, the undersigned persons in the Parish of *Kilmakelogue*, in the Diocese of *Wexford*, in the County of *Kilkenny*, being three or more persons each of whom is respectively liable to and charged with the annual payment of the sum of Three Pounds or upwards for Rent Charge in lieu of Composition for Tithes within the said Parish (other than Rent Charge which became vested in the Commissioners of Church Temporalities in Ireland under, or by virtue, of the Irish Church Act, 1869, or the Acts amending the same), to make application to the Justices of the Peace for the said County, at the next ensuing Quarter Sessions of the Peace, to be held on the *15<sup>th</sup>* day of *October* 18 *89*, at *Thomastown* and for the Division of *Thomastown*, in the County of *Kilkenny*, to have the average price of *wheat* for the seven years preceding inquired of and ascertained, in order that the composition for Tithes within the said Parish may be varied and diminished according to Law for the ensuing seven years in proportion to such average price of *wheat*, and to have the applotment thereof amended accordingly, and the Rent Charges payable in lieu thereof, (other than such Rent Charges as became vested, as aforesaid, in the Commissioners of Church Temporalities in Ireland,) varied and diminished in like proportion, pursuant to the Provisions of the 1 & 2 Victoria, chapter 109, and all other statutes in that behalf made and provided.
