and just composition for all tithes arising growing yielded or
payable within the Parish of Kilmaculig in the County of Mayo do
hereby certify that the true and just amount of composition for all
tithes whatever within the said Parish is One hundred & thirty seven
pounds fifteen shillings & six pence by the year of which sum One hundred &
twenty seven pounds fifteen shillings & six pence is due and pay-
able to the Rev. Francis Rottledge as a composition for the tithes
claimable by him as Rector and Vicar of the said Parish and the
sum of Ten pounds & two pence halfpenny by the year is due and payable
to the Rev. James Quinn as a composition for the two thirds
of the tithes of the townlands of Kilmaculig claimable by him as
Prebendary of Kilmaculig and we do further certify that the
assess^{ment} of the said tithes being the same Principally Crown in such County
for the Period of seven years ending on the first day of Nov:
1821 is fifteen shillings and two pence halfpenny per Acre accord-
ing to the Public gazette assize sheet given under our
Hands and Seal at Kilmaculig the 12th day of October

1827
