We the Rev<sup>d</sup> Cecil Crampton of Cong and John Flynn  
of Ballymagiblow Esq. Commissioners duly appointed and  
sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the  
fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth  
~~intituled~~ "An act to provide for the establishing of  
Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time"  
to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition  
for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable  
within the Parish of Kilmainmore in the County  
of Mayo Do hereby certify that the true and just  
Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within  
the said Parish is Four Hundred and Thirty three  
pounds eight Shillings starting by the year. which  
Sum of Four Hundred and thirty three pounds  
eight Shillings the whole is due and payable to the  
Rev<sup>d</sup> Francis Rutledge as a composition for the Tithes  
claimable by him as Rector and Vicar of the said  
Parish

And we further certify that the average price  
of Oats being the Corn principally grown in such  
County for the period of seven years ending on the  
first day of November 1821 is fifteen Shillings & two  
pence per Barrel according to the Public Gazette  
average sheet
