

J. Thomas Fitzgerald, Commissioner duly appointed and sworn
 under and by virtue of an act made in the second and
 third year of the reign of King William the fourth entitled an
 act to amend three acts passed respectively in the fourth
 fifth and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of his
 late Majesty King George the fourth providing for the Estab-
 lishing of Composition for Tithes in Ireland and to make such
 Composition permanent to ascertain and fix a true and just Compo-
 sition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within
 the Parish of Kilmadum in the County Kilkenny do hereby Certify
 that the true and just Amount of Composition for all
 Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Two Hundred
 and Ten pounds by the year of which sum of Two Hundred
 and Ten pounds the Sum of One Hundred and forty
 pounds is due and payable to the Mayor and Citizens of
 the City of Kilkenny as a Composition for the Rectorial Tithe
 And the Sum of Seventy pounds of said Two Hundred
 and Ten pounds is due and payable to the Rev. James
 Molesworth, Parson as a composition for the Vicarial Tithe
 as Vicar thereof

And I do further Certify that the average price of
 wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County
 for the period of seven years ending on the first day
 of November Eighteen Hundred and thirty is Thirty two
 shillings and ^{one} half penny per Barrel -
