

I Thomas Fitzgerald, Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under, and, by, virtue of an Act made in the second and third Year of the Reign of King William Fourth entitled an Act to Amend Three Acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth and in the seventh and eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty, King George the Fourth providing for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland to make such Compositions permanent, to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Kilmadumoy in the County, Kilkenny.

do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is One Hundred and fifty seven pounds fourteen shillings by the year of which Sum of one Hundred and fifty seven pounds fourteen shillings is due and payable to Rev^d. S. J. Roberts as a Composition for the Rectorial and Vicarial Tithes of all said Parish claimable by him as Rector and Vicar thereof. And I do further certify that the average price of wheat being the corn principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November Eighteen Hundred and thirty is thirty two shillings and one half penny per Barrel.
