Donogh of Widdowmount and Edward Hartigan of Wiltmore of the County of Galway, Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the Fourth year of the reign of King George the Fourth (intituled "An Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time") to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable within the Parish of Kilmalinoe orise Kilmalinoe in the County of Galway. Do hereby certify that the true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is Seventy Seven Pounds, ten Shillings Ster. by the year of which sum of Seventy Seven pounds ten Shillings Ster. Three Fourth parts are due and payable to the Rev. James Strange Rector as a composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the said Parish; and one fourth ^{part} is due and payable to the Bishop of the Diocess of Clonfert. And we do further certify that the Average price of Oats being the corn principally grown in such County, for the period of seven years ending the first day of November, One thousand, Eight hundred and Twenty One is Ten Shillings and Six pence by the Barrel. Given under our hands: this Sixteenth day of October, One thousand, eight hundred, and Twenty Three.
