

We Thomas Mahon and Charles Mahon Esqrs duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the Fourth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth, intituled "An Act to provide for the establishing a Composition for Fishes in Ireland for a limited Time" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Fishes arising, growing, yielded, or payable within the Parish of Kilfidane in the County of Clare, and Diocese of Killaloe, do hereby certify, that the true and just Amount of Composition for all Fishes whatsoever within the said Parish, is Two Hundred and ninety Pounds Sterl. by the Year, of which Sum of Two Hundred and ninety Pounds Sterl. One Hundred and eighty Pounds Sterling are due and Payable to Bindon Scott Esq. as a Composition for the Fishes claimable by him as Lay Impropriator of the said Parish, and one Hundred and ten Pounds Sterling are due to the Rev. James Martin the Vicar of said Parish.

And we do further certify that the Average price of Oats, being the Corn principally grown in such County, for the Period of Seven Years, ending on the First day of November 1821 and twenty one is fifteen Shillings and 2 1/4 per Barrel. Dated and Given under our Hands this 31st Day of October 1823 and Twenty three.
