Arthur Browne a Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third Year of the Reign of King William the Fourth intituled "an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh and eighth Years of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent" to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for that portion of the Improper Tithes the property of Joseph Deane Freeman and Frederick Massey Esq: the Heir of said Joseph Deane Freeman, arising growing yielded or payable within the Townlands of Moorstown and Banetstown in the Parish of St. Finian and County of Limerick, do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for said portion of Improper Tithes is Fifty seven pounds ten shillings by the year, which sum of Fifty seven pounds ten shillings is due and payable to Joseph Deane Freeman, or his Heir Frederick Massey Esq: as a Composition for the Tithes of the Two Kind parts claimable
