ther certify, that the average price of
Wheat, being the corn principally
grown in said County, for the period of
Seven years, next preceding the 1st of Novr.
1830, is one pound, twelve shillings, and
one halfpenny, per Bushel.

The parishioners of Millington parish,
have not paid the Rectorial tithes (they
being Lay) for the period of Seven years
next preceding the 1st of Novr. 1830, with
the exception of a few pounds. I have
therefore struck the average (being
two thirds) of the sum agreed upon
at a special Vestry, & he paid to
the Vicar.
